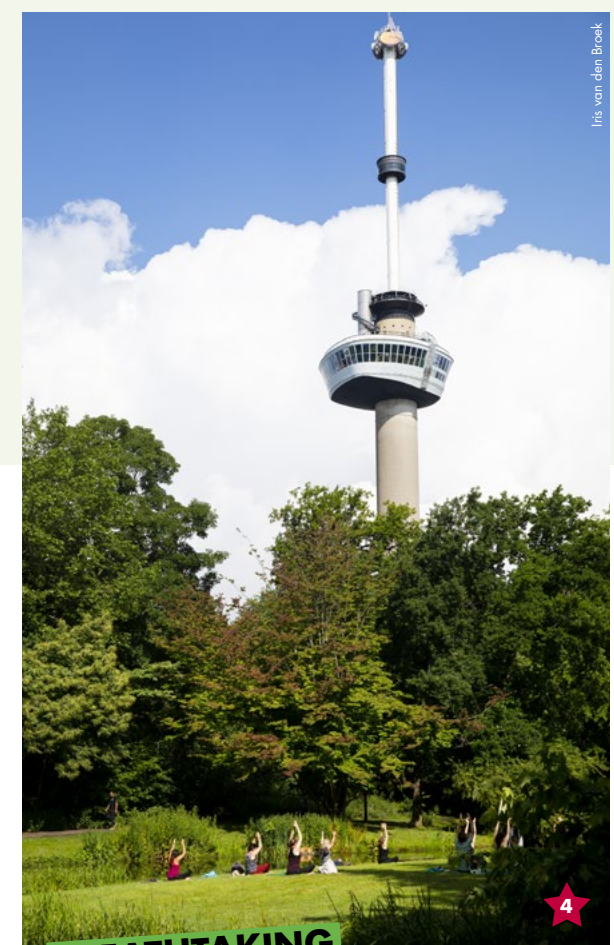

BREATHTAKING VIEWS

EUROMAST

In the national monument het Park, with its winding paths, ancient trees and lush greenery, the Euromast (1960) is the 'golden oldie' of the Rotterdam skyline. The panoramic view from the Euroscoop at 180 metres high is even more impressive than the striking structure. Book an overnight stay or dinner at the top. Or abseil down. The historic Schoonoord Gardens (1860) is a hidden gem next to het Park.

This City Map is your guide to the city and a true treasure trove. It will lead you to the highlights but also to locations off the beaten track. Enjoy the enriching experience!



UNMISSABLE HOTSPOT

DEPOT BOIJMANS VAN BEUNINGEN

Can you spot yourself in the mirrored facade of this first publicly accessible art storage building? It's as pioneering as it is logical; why shouldn't a depot have several functions besides storing art? You can also admire art at Depot Boijmans Van Beuningen (2021), visit the roof forest and enjoy a delicious meal at the rooftop restaurant Renide. Then, stroll through Museumplein and visit the innovative exhibitions at the Kunsthal (1992).



KONINKLIJKE SPIDO

Spido has been a Rotterdam household name for over a century. Hop aboard for the harbour tour: a short, compelling impression of Rotterdam's pride in 75 minutes. Tours and themed cruises set sail from the foot of the Erasmus Bridge daily. In eco mode, the ships sail slower and more sustainably. So you can get a good view of the city. There is plenty to see, especially in the Port of Rotterdam – the largest in Europe.



MARKTHAL

Welcome to the Markthal (2014), renowned for its striking architecture and rich offerings. Market stalls, shops and restaurants nestle beneath the 228 apartments, in the spot where the medieval settlement of Rotterdam grew into present-day Rotterdam! Experience the lively Binnenrotte on market days (Tuesdays and Saturdays), set against a backdrop of the distinctive Cube Houses (1984) and close to the many terraces at historic Oudehaven.



MUST SEE



FLOATING FARM

The Floating Farm is an excellent example of how Rotterdam showcases innovative approaches to maximise use of its water-rich surroundings. This groundbreaking floating farm opened in 2019 and illustrates, innovatively and circularly, food production in the city. The 40 cows on the farm are fed with by-products from Schiedam mills and Rotterdam breweries, like the Stadshaven Brouwerij – a sustainable state-of-the-art brewery and waterfront gastropub.

MORE TIPS AND INFORMATION!

PUBLIC TRANSPORT
Rotterdam has an excellent public transport system, provided by RET. Use a valid public transport card to access all public transport in our city. These are available at metro stations, RET Service Points, Rotterdam Tourist Information and via the RET Barcode App. Always check in and out with your ticket! Or use OVpay and check in and out with your debit card, credit card or mobile. Travel info: ret.nl/en or 9292.nl/en

CYCLING
Get to know Rotterdam and the surrounding areas as a local: by bike. Rotterdam has plenty of cycle paths and is part of the cycle junction network. Hire a bicycle from your hotel or from one of the local bike rental companies. You can also make use of the shared-bikes on offer from various providers or you can use an OV bicycle – for which you need a personal public transport chip card (OV-chipkaart) and Dutch bank account.

GUIDED TOURS
Explore the city with an experienced guide from one of the many tour companies in Rotterdam. During these walking or cycling tours, you will learn about Rotterdam's history, culture and architecture and you'll discover the city's best, and sometimes lesser known, places.

WALKING
Rotterdam is a lovely city to explore on foot, offering an abundance of sights during a short stroll or a more extended city walk. You can enhance your exploration using apps or maps that highlight all the key attractions. Consider downloading the apps of Rotterdam Routes and Rewriters (offering walking routes showcasing street art) to embark on your fascinating journey!

SHOPPING AREA
Rotterdam is a world city with several shopping areas, the largest of which is in the city centre. Each area has its own character to suit the diversity of desires and people.

HISTORIC DELFHAVEN

Delfshaven is teeming with history. This is where the pilgrim fathers embarked on their ship to America in 1620 and where Piet Hein was born. The Pelgrimvaderskerk (1417) was named after these colonists. Wander past the marina and relics of the former city from when Rotterdam earned its money with herring and gin. Wheatmill De Distilleerkeetel and the Zakkendragershuisje (1653) are evidence of this. This place gives you an impression of pre-war Rotterdam. Antique and trinket shops, cafes, beer and gin pubs and artists' studios now thrive in this unique atmosphere.

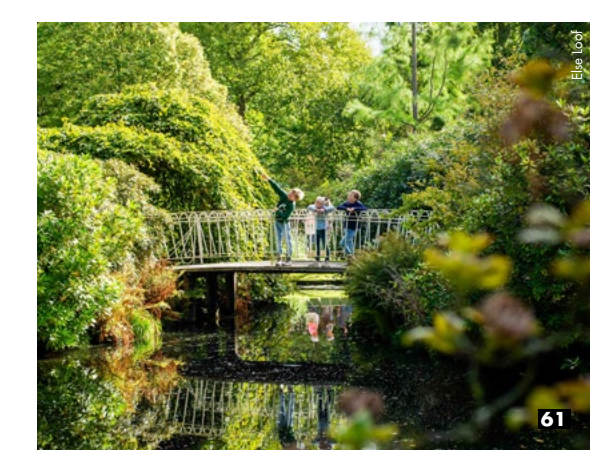


MUST SEE LAURENSKERK

The Gothic Laurenskerk (1449 - 1525) survived the bombing and is the only remnant of medieval Rotterdam. The church makes an impressive venue for the concerts that are regularly held here. You can climb the centuries-old tower. Once back down, rest on one of the small but lovely city park of Grotekerplein. Did you know this was the birthplace of thinker and writer Desiderius Erasmus (1466)? You'll find his bronze statue in the park in front of the church.

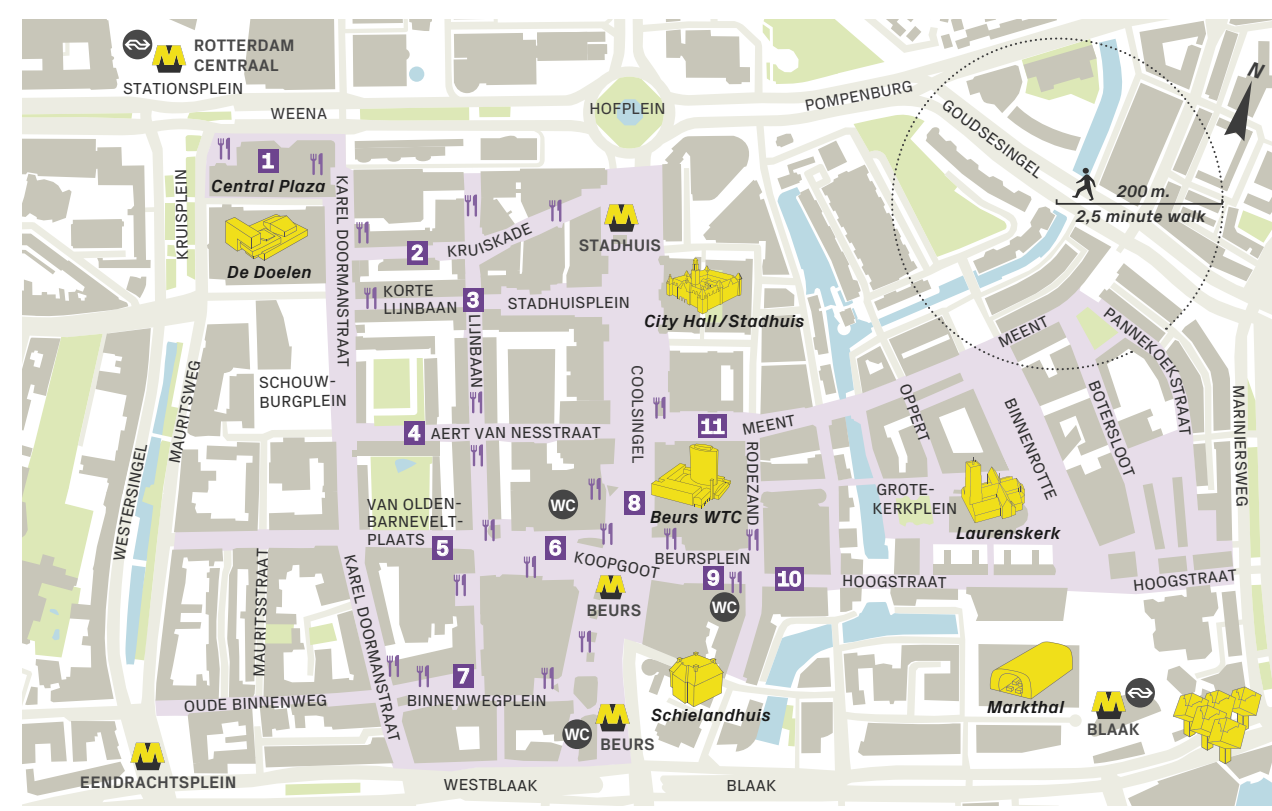
TROMPENBURG GARDENS & ARBORETUM

The Green Museum of Rotterdam is renowned for its exceptional collection. The globally acclaimed Trompenburg collection comprises thousands of diverse plants and trees. Nowhere else in Europe can you find such a variety of oaks and the rhododendron and wisteria collections are must-sees! This municipal monument offers an expansive 8-hectare botanical green experience on the edge of the city centre, including traditional English-style gardens, a developing food forest and a desert greenhouse with cacti and succulents.



SS ROTTERDAM

This steam and cruise ship sailed all over the world between 1959 and 2000. After her retirement, the ss Rotterdam was given a second life as a hotel boat. Take the Watertaxi from Willemsplein to the ss Rotterdam and imagine yourself on the Love Boat on the Promenade Deck (with swimming pool). There is also plenty to do ashore – on Kalendrecht. Dine at Deliplein, have a drink at Café de Ouwehoer, visit the Fenix Food Factory or enjoy a performance at Conny Janssen Danst or the intimate Theater Walhalla.



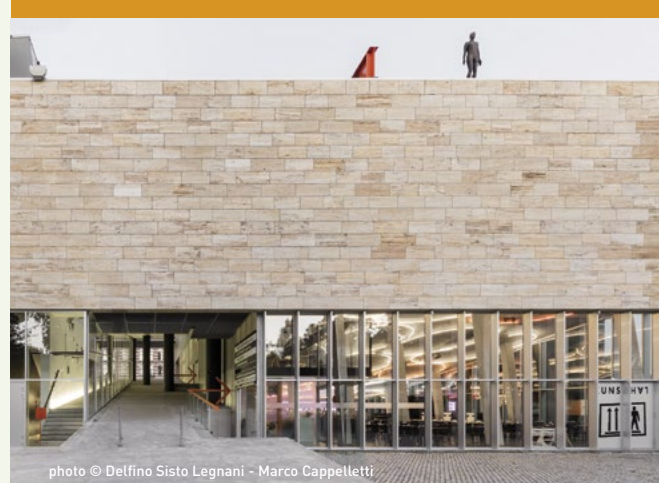

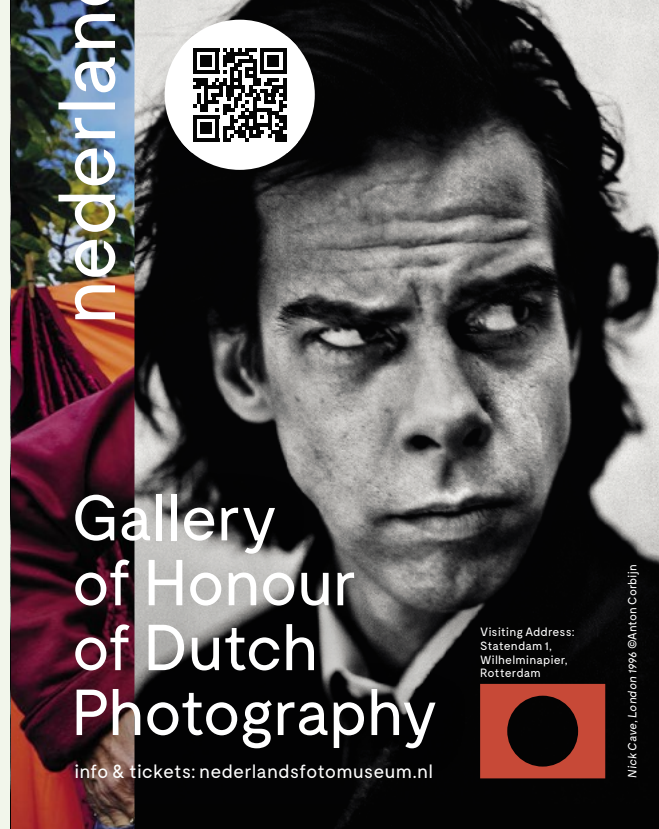
